### **DataChambers Completes Triad Data Center Expansion**

- **More than 60% of new space now committed to client companies**
- **Company to add new sales reps in Charlotte and Research Triangle Park**

Winston-Salem, N.C. (January 26, 2009)

The North Carolina-based technology firm DataChambers today announced the successful completion of an project to add capacity to its Winston-Salem data center. Just four months after the project was first announced, more than 60 percent of the new space is already committed to information technology clients.

“Though we expanded in anticipation of growing demand, we’re gratified to see contracts materialize so quickly,” said Nicholas Kottyan, CEO of DataChambers. “Experience shows that during tough economic times, businesses seek technology providers who can help them get more out of their limited information technology budgets. That has been the key to our success to date and one of the reasons we continue to thrive.”

To accelerate the company’s growth trajectory and fill the remainder of the new space, DataChambers plans to add new sales representatives in Charlotte and Research Triangle Park. The expanded data center these employees represent is located 18 feet underground in a blast-resistant building and houses dozens of systems for DataChambers’ clients nationwide. Some use the center to host their primary network or a network node, while others use the facility for the backup resources they need to recover in the event of a disaster or system failure.

The renovated data center features a 25 percent expansion in square footage and fire protection systems, a 40 percent increase in uninterruptible power supplies and air conditioning, and a 20 percent increase in video surveillance and security systems. The project was completed on time and approximately 15 percent under the anticipated \$60 million budget.
